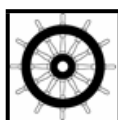

Product description

SeaWork is a non-insulated anti-exposure suit designed to be worn without a lifejacket. The suit is made of watertight material with neoprene hood, cuffs and gloves. The colour of the suit is orange/black.

Application/Limitation

As this is an non insulated anti-exposure suit to be worn without lifejacket the following applies:

- It have to be worn with warm clothing;
- suit has to be fitted with a thermal lining;
- suit has to be fitted with an approved indicating light (wheelmarked);
- suit has to be fitted with a whistle; and
- suit has to be fitted with an VHF pocket.
- Retro-reflective materials shall be of approved type (wheelmarked).
- The design assessment is based on IMO Res. MSC 48(66) as amended by IMO Res. MSC 207(81).
- Production and installation testing shall be carried out according to IMO Res. MSC. 81(70), part 2.
