Product description

"SWEDAC Deck Covering System V2"

Deck covering system consisting of a viscoelastic layer called "Swedac ACM" (waterbased damping layer, 1-1.5 mm thick, density 1350 kg/m³), covered by a 10-15 mm constraining layer of Weber floor 4660 Marine Elastic (weight per area approximately 2 kg/mm/m² of wet layer (1.9kg dry layer)).

Application/Limitation

Primary deck covering, not generating excessive quantities of smoke nor toxic products in fire.

The product may also be used as floor covering in accordance with IMO 2010 FTP code part 5 appendix 4 paragraph 4.9.2.

The product may be applied over any steel or non-combustible material.

Approved colour: Grey
Maximum organic content: Svedac ACM 32%, Weber 4660 5%

Not to be used as an integrated part of a horizontal class A division unless tested as such.

Each product is to be supplied with its manual for installation and use.
