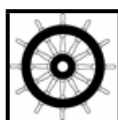

Product description

"Pilot QD Primer/Pilot WF"

Paint system consisting of acrylic emulsion top coat "Pilot WF" (max. dry film thickness 55 µm) and alkyd based primer with a zinc phosphate "Pilot QD Primer" (max. dry film thickness 80 µm).

Application/Limitation

Approved for use as a low flame spread surface material, not generating excessive quantities of smoke nor toxic products in fire. Approved for use throughout the accommodation.

Approved for use as paint systems on a metallic substrate with thickness of at least 1.5 mm.

Topcoating "Pilot WF":

- Approved colour: all
- Max. organic content: 100 wt% per dry film thickness

Primer "Pilot QD Primer":

- Approved colour: bluegreen
- Max. organic content: 24 wt% per dry film thickness
