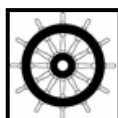

A U.S. Coast Guard approval number will be assigned to the equipment when the production module has been completed and will appear on the production module certificate (module D, E or F), as allowed by the "Agreement between the United States of America and the EEA EFTA states on the mutual recognition of Certificates of Conformity for Marine Equipment" signed 17 October 2005, and amended by Decision No 1/2019 dated February 22nd, 2019.

The mark of conformity may only be affixed to the above type approved equipment and a Manufacturer's Declaration of Conformity issued when the production-surveillance module (D, E or F) of Annex B of the MED is fully complied with and controlled by a written inspection agreement with a Notified Body. The product liability rests with the manufacturer or his representative in accordance with Directive 2014/90/EU.

This certificate is valid for equipment, which is conform to the approved type. The manufacturer shall inform DNV GL AS of any changes to the approved equipment. This certificate remains valid unless suspended, withdrawn, recalled or cancelled.

Should the specified regulations or standards be amended during the validity of this certificate, the product is to be re-approved before being placed on board a vessel to which the amended regulations or standards apply.



Product description

Brødrene Aa fire restricting material, consists of a fire reinforced polymer (FRP) sandwich insulated on the exposed side with one layer of SeaRox SL 720 secured with washers and screw pins.

The approved product is described in detail below. The product is in general only approved for use on vessels built according to HSC Code or rules based on this Code (examples: yacht, navy ships, patrol boats, etc.).

The fire insulation is manufactured by Rockwool International A/S, Denmark (or by other Rockwool factories defined by the MED-D certificates in question).

Application/Limitation

Some product specific information is removed from the Internet version of this certificate, please contact supplier for details.

Only the combined product (insulation and FRP structure) is approved as a fire restricting material. The fire hazard shall be on the insulated side. The product is to be installed as tested, with the below details considered being the main issues. See the installation manual for more details.

Insulation, foil and pins

The insulation shall be applied on the exposed side of the FRP structure (bulkhead or deck) with 1 x 50 mm SeaRox SL 720 (32 kg/m³) covered with aluminium foil.

The insulation layer shall be secured with pins and washers. The pins are screwed into the FRP structure and shall be installed with a nominal spacing of 450 x 500 mm with approximately 50 mm distance to joints.

FRP structure

The insulation was tested on a sandwich composite structure with polymer core and carbon fibre reinforced laminates.

Application of other FRP materials

The systems are in general only approved for composite with same exposed laminate as the one tested. On a case by case basis other equivalent composites may be applied when confirmed acceptable and documented by the maker and found to be acceptable by the flag administration.

Other documents

The insulation material and any surface materials used have to be approved according to the Marine Equipment Directive and bear the Mark of Conformity.

Each product is to be supplied with its manual for installation, use and maintenance.
