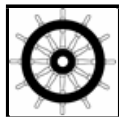

TEFROKA® PU-1-L Mortar Light is used as floor covering on inside and outside areas. It consists of a two-component polyurethane system and may be mixed with a filler to a light mortar.

Max. thickness: 11,7 mm ± 0,5 mm
Nominal area weight: ~ 0,85 kg/m²/mm

Application/Limitation

Approved for use as low flame spread surface material, not generating excessive quantities of smoke nor toxic products in fire.

Approved for use as floor covering on any low flame-spread floor covering, steel or non-combustible material.

Several layers of floor coverings are acceptable provided that each layer is approved according to the Marine Equipment Directive and bear the mark of Conformity.

The product may also be used as primary deck covering.

Each product is to be supplied with its instruction for installation, use and maintenance.
