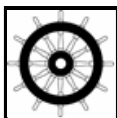

Product description

“JCP-B3 Type B-15 Class Bulkhead”

Is the bulkhead panels composed of 49 mm thick insulation core, BSS rock wool (density 120 kg/m³, produced by Weihai Bosheng Advanced Material) covered from both sides with 0.5 mm thick steel plate.

The panel can be equipped inside with:

- three 62 mm x 25 mm longitudinal cable grooves,
- three 100 mm x 6 mm longitudinal air layers,
- one 5 mm thick air layer.

Insulation is glued to the steel plates by means of polyurethane adhesive.

The plates are connected using notch nodes, with 27 mm deep notch.

Total panel thickness: 50 mm

Application/Limitation

Approved for use as a vertical fire retarding division of class B-15.

Maximum panel size: 600 mm x 2470 mm (W x H)

The insulation materials and adhesives used have to be approved according to the Marine Equipment Directive and bear the Mark of Conformity. This requirement may also be applicable for surface materials used, if required by relevant rules and regulations.

Each product is to be supplied with its manual for installation and maintenance.
