Application/Limitation

Approved for use as low flame spread surface material, not generating excessive quantities of smoke nor toxic products in fire.

Approved for all colour variations.

Maximum organic content: 35.9 %

Approved for use as floor covering on any non-combustible, non metallic material.

Several layers of floor coverings are acceptable provided that each layer is approved according to the Marine Equipment Regulation and bear the Mark of Conformity.

Any adhesive used, other than the one used during testing, has to be tested for low flame spread characteristics according to IMO 2010 FTP Code Part 5 and to be approved according to the Marine Equipment Regulation and bear the Mark of Conformity.

Each product is to be supplied with its manual for installation, use and maintenance.
