Product description

"A60-KL-05"

is a single leafed hinged door. The door leaf is composed, seen from outside to inside:

- 13 mm steel plate,
- three layers of 3 mm graphite plates from Sam Jung CNG,
- two layers of 25 mm Hi Wool insulation core with nominal density of 110 kg/m³ from KCC Corporation,
- 3 mm steel plate (insulation cover plate).

The door leaf is fitted with 25 x 4 mm fire door seal and 20 x 40 mm fire retardant packing and is stiffened with six horizontal and one vertical steel L-profiles (carlings) with dimensions 25 x 25 x 5 mm (W x B x T).

The door leaf is attached to the door frame with 4 hinges.

The door frame is made of a 9 mm thick steel plate which is welded to the bulkhead.

Total door leaf thickness is 75 mm.

The door can be opened by handle assembly and it is equipped with latch assembly which serves as a linked locking mechanism consisting of seven locking points.

For further details see the drawing listed under Type Approval documentation below.

Application/Limitation

The door is approved for installation in steel bulkheads of class A-60. Installation of the door in bulkheads made of other materials (aluminium, FRP, etc.) are subject to case-by-case approval.

Max. size of door leaf:	1265 mm x 2275 mm (W x H)
Max. size of clear opening:	1200 mm x 2200 mm (W x H)

Restricted application: fire against 3 mm thick steel inner/insulation cover plate.

Any surface materials used have to be approved for smoke and toxicity and low flame spread characteristics (IMO 2010 FTP Code parts 2 and 5 or IMO FTPC Parts 2 and 5 when in compliance with the 2010 FTP Code Ch. 5.2 and 8) when required according to relevant rules and regulations.

Note that this is a fire safety certificate which only covers fire technical properties (i.e. not to cover strength evaluations related to watertightness, weathertightness, etc.).

A fire door of marginally larger dimensions than a fire-tested fire door may be individually assessed and accepted by Flag Administration (or Recognized Organization acting on its behalf) for a specific project with the same classification, provided documented compliance with IMO MSC.1/Circ.1319.

Each product is to be supplied with its manual for installation, use and maintenance.
