Product description

Seven OceanS standard emergency ration for lifeboats and liferafts. The ration consists of 9 bars of compressed biscuit, each bar wrapped in grease-proof paper. The 9 bars are sealed in a polythene bag, which in turn is enclosed within a sealad shrinkwrapped foil laminate. The outer packaging is a lightweight cardboard box.

The energy value of the complete pack is at least 10 000 kJ and the net weight at least 500 g. Each pak is acceptable as a ration for one person.
