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Product description

Offshore frame for transport flow bin IBC tank.

Max. external dimensions (LxWxH): 1315 x 1315 x 2080 mm
Tare mass¹⁾: 1082 kg

¹⁾tare mass has to be confirmed by weighing. The sum of the tare mass and the payload shall never exceed the max. gross mass as stated on the front page of this certificate.

Application/Limitation

Design temperature : 0 °C
Min. shackle bolt diameter : 21.6 mm

This offshore frame is designed, and type approved to transport IBCs with liquid or solid cargoes that are classified as dangerous goods according to IMDG Code Ch. 6.5. The Type approval covers only the frame, and the IBC is assumed to be delivered with separate adequate certification.

This Offshore Container design is only for use in temperate climate and shall follow the restrictions and marking requirements according to DNV-ST-E271 Section 10. Area restriction, "Only to be used between 36° North and 36° South and in Australian Waters", is to be included in the product certificate

DNV surveyor has to witness important production and test events and issue Form no. 71.08a "Certificate for Offshore Container" for each container, and any additional certificate as required by the competent authority.

Production strength tests (All point lifting) to be carried out according to DNV 2.7-1 and after agreement with the DNV surveyor.

The container product certificates are only valid when the containers are fitted with a lifting set approved by DNV according to DNV 2.7-1

Type Approval documentation

Tests carried out

Prototype tested according to the requirements.

Marking of product

Each container has to be marked with:

- Data plates and inspection plates according to DNV 2.7-1 Section 10 requirements
- External marking according to DNV 2.7-1 Section 10 requirements
- DNV decal for offshore containers
- NV mark to be hard stamped on frame
- Manufacturer's Serial Number is to be welded on the frame

Periodical assessment

In order to maintain the validity of the type approval certificate, periodical assessments should be carried out according to DNVGL-SE-0284 at 2 and 3.5 year intervals. Periodical assessments will, when possible, be harmonised with other surveys and audits carried out.
